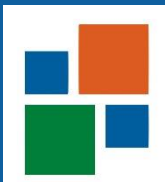

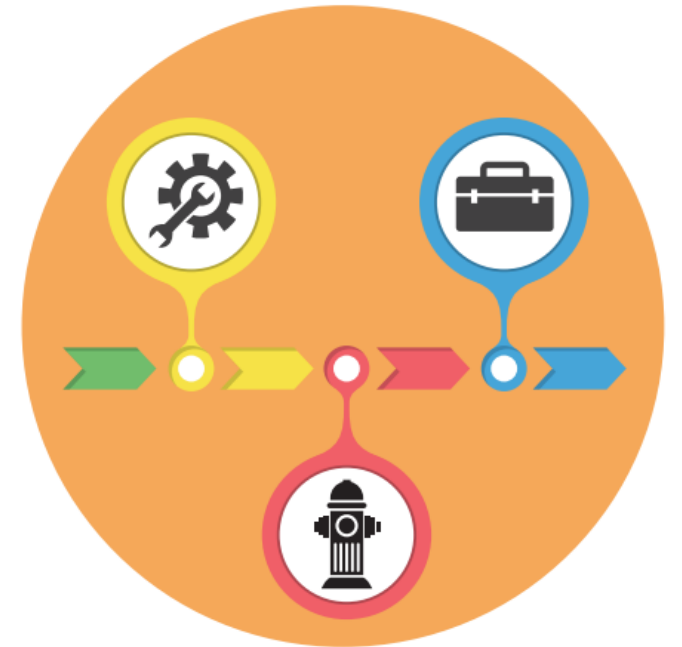

Implementation Considerations

- ArcGIS Online license is required for collecting and editing
- Mobile tablet device and wireless data service are required
- Two-week lead time for set up
- Training by GIS Specialist is necessary for new users
- A data quality check-in review process is employed before making the edits available in MapOffice
- Utility stakeholders may be engaged to verify edits
