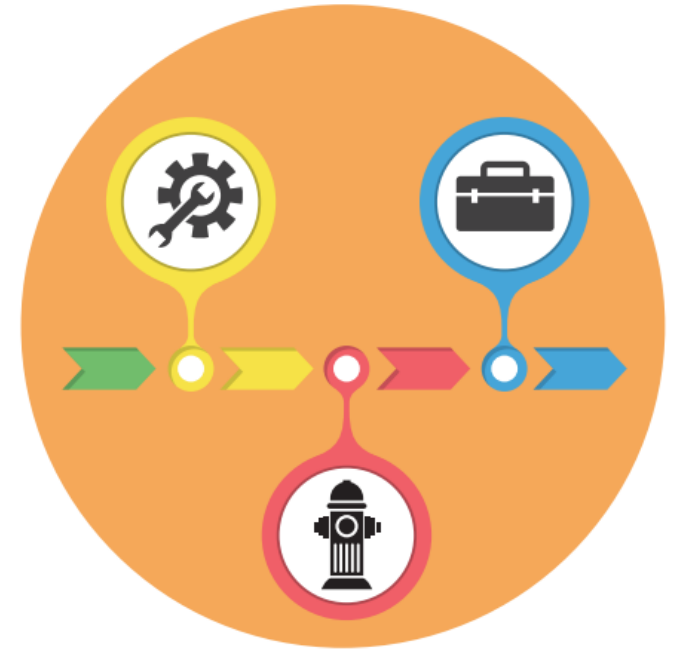

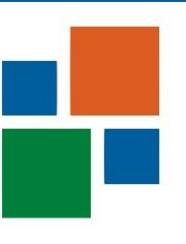


# Implementation Considerations

- Mobile tablet device is required, wireless service is recommended
- Training by GIS Specialist is necessary for new users
- Editing occurs on a versioned database
